



November 2014 Block of the Month Winter Holiday Bow Ties

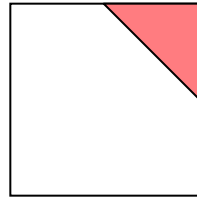
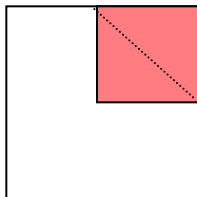


For each block you will need white, or white tone-on-tone fabric, and a fabric in a color or theme that is appropriate to a winter holiday. NO, it does not have to be Christmas. Any holiday that happens during winter will do.

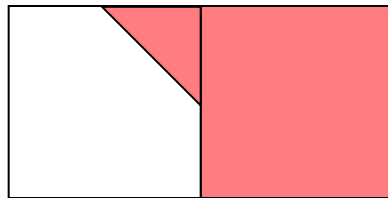
- From your white (or tone-on-tone) cut two (2) 4-1/2" squares.
- From your holiday fabric cut two (2) 4-1/2" squares AND two (2) 2" squares.

To assemble:

1. Using a marking pencil, lightly draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each 2" square. "Snowball" one of the 2" squares onto a corner of each white/tone-on-tone square. Trim the seam allowance to 1/4" and press it toward the holiday fabric.



2. Sew one of the 4-1/2" holiday squares onto each of the "snowballed" squares so that one side of the little holiday fabric triangle is included. Press the seam toward the holiday square.



3. Place the units, right sides together, with the triangles in the middle. Match the center seams so they lock snugly together. Stitch in one long seam. Press the seam allowance open or to one side.
