VINTAGE VALENTINES
9 ½ unfinished blocks



COLORS: For an old-fashioned Valentine's look, use red prints that have brown or gold hints on cream print backgrounds; stitch down using brown/gold thread.

1 BLOCK

- 1: Cut a 10 inch cream or cream print background.
2. Trace Cupid on fusible web. You may reverse for more variety.
3. Iron onto the back side of red Cupid fabric and cut out your Cupid; remove paper.
4. Arrange onto cream background and iron down.
5. Stitch down with small zigzag or buttonhole stitch using brown/gold thread.
6. Trim block to exactly 9 ½ inches.
