

OCQG Block of the Month
July 2016
Disappearing Four-Patch

All seams are 1/4"

Cut:

A Floral print: 2—5" squares

White (tone-on-tone or solid): 2—5" squares

Make four-patch block. Cut 1" from center seam on all four sides (photo on left).

Rearrange four corners and rotate center by one turn (photo on right).

Sew as a basic nine-patch. Feel free to repress seams to help your match points.

Block should measure 8 1/2" square
