

OCQG Block of the Month
NOVEMBER 2015
Delectable Mountain Block

Cut

1— 8 ½" square from a print fabric that reads light

1 — 8 ½" square from a blue or green or purple print fabric that reads dark

Cut both fabrics once on the diagonal and sew one triangle of light to one triangle of dark to make two new squares. Press to dark. Cut these to 8" sq. making sure diagonal seam runs corner to corner.

Layer these two squares, right sides together with colors opposite of each other (seams should nest together). Cut 4—2" strips through both squares. Picture on left is what these cuts look like when separated. Rearrange strips as in picture on right. (photos from **Bonnie Hunter's** Free Pattern site, link below)



Sew strips together and then these two blocks together to make 1 block that measures 8 x 12 ½"
