OCQG Block of the Month JULY 2015 Four-Patch

Cut:

2—2 ½" squares of white tone-on-tone

2—2 ½" squares of Thirties' prints (can be matching or different fabrics)

Sew into a four-patch unit pressing the first seams toward the print and twirling the center so the last seam goes in opposite directions to reduce bulk (second photo). The twirled seam is optional; it's ok if you skip that part! Four-Patch should measure 4 ½" square.

Put 4 DIFFERENT Four Patch units (not the same prints) into one baggie. Make up to five baggies of four each.
