

OCQG Block of the Month
January 2018

9" Yellow Churn Dash Block



For each block, cut:

One 3 ½" square of white or black background fabric
Two 3 7/8" squares of white or black background fabric
Four 2" x 3 ½" rectangles of white or black background fabric
Four 2" x 3 ½" rectangles of yellow fabric
Two 3 7/8" squares of yellow fabric

To make the block:

Cut the 3 7/8" squares once diagonally and sew the resulting triangles into yellow/background squares. Match the 2" x 3 ½" rectangles into yellow/background pairs and sew together. Press the seams toward whichever fabric is darker. Arrange the nine squares and assemble as shown.

Finished block should measure 9 ½" square.
