

OCQG Block of the Month  
February 2018

**9" Red Jacob's Ladder Block**



For each block, cut:

Two 3 7/8" squares of white or black background fabric

Ten 2" squares of white or black background fabric

Two 3 7/8" squares of red fabric

Ten 2" squares of red fabric

To make the block:

Cut the 3 7/8" squares once diagonally and sew the resulting triangles into red/background squares. Match the 2" squares into red/background pairs and sew together. Press the seams toward whichever fabric is darker. Sew the red/background two-patches into four-patches. Arrange the four triangle squares and five four-patch squares as shown. Assemble and press.

Finished block should measure 9 1/2" square.
