

OCQG Block of the Month
March 2017

6" Single Irish Chain Block

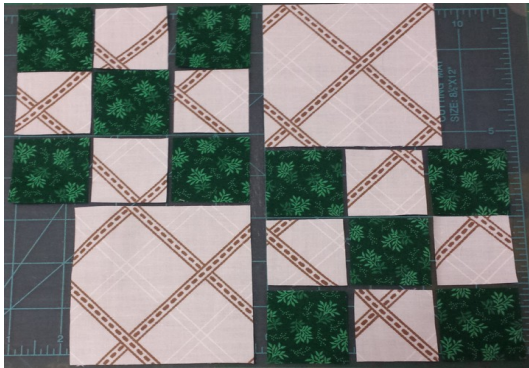
All seams are 1/4".

For each block, cut:

Ten 1 1/2" squares of green fabric

Eight 1 1/2" squares of light fabric

Two 3 1/2" squares of light fabric



Arrange and sew the 1 1/2" squares into two nine-patch blocks, as shown, with the green squares in the center and corners. Nine-patch blocks should measure 3 1/2" square.



Alternate the nine-patch squares with the 3 1/2" light squares. Assemble into a four-patch grid as shown. Press. Finished block should measure 6 1/2" square.
