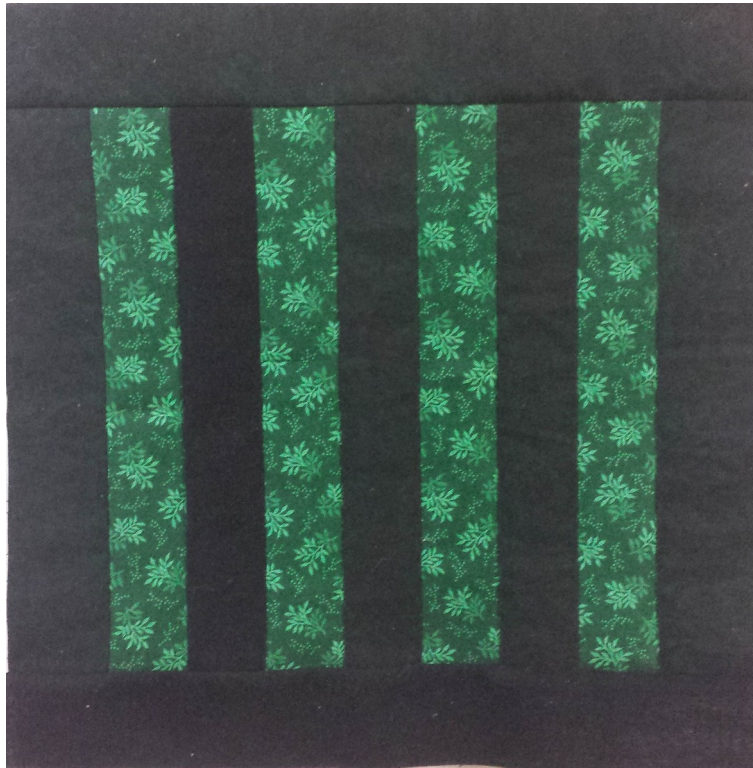


OCQG Block of the Month
March 2018

9" Green Colorbars Block



For each block, cut:

Two 1 ½" x 9 ½" rectangles of white or black background fabric

Five 1 ½" x 7 ½" rectangles of white or black background fabric

Four 1 ½" x 7 ½" rectangles of green fabric

To make the block:

Alternating green and the background color, sew the 7 ½" rectangles together side-by-side to form a 7 ½" x 9 ½" rectangle. Press the seams toward whichever fabric is darker. Sew the 9 ½" background rectangles on either side of the striped rectangles, as shown. Press the seams toward the background fabric.

Finished block should measure 9 ½" square.

Bonus Difficulty Level!

The four green rectangles may be made of the same fabric, four different fabrics... or they may be made of *pieced* fabric, so that each rectangle contains multiple fabrics!
