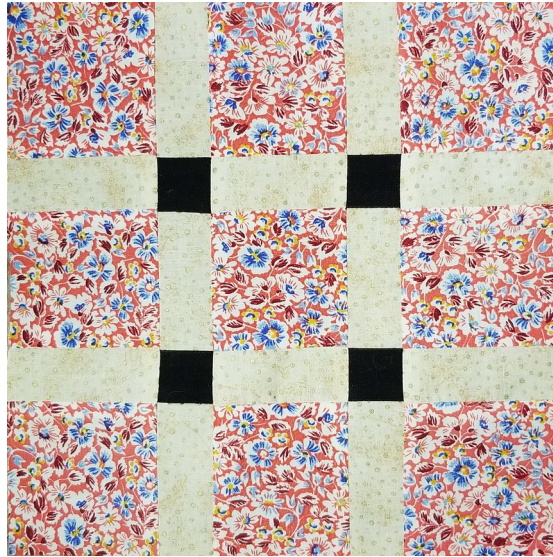


OCQG Block of the Month  
March 2019

### Floral Tic-Tac-Toe Block



For each block, cut:

From medium to dark floral fabric:

Nine 3" squares

From black fabric

Four 1 1/2" squares

From white or cream fabric:

Twelve 1 1/2" x 3" rectangles

To make the block:

All seams are 1/4" wide.

Sew three rows of floral square/light rectangle/floral square/light rectangle/floral square. Press seams toward the squares.

Sew two rows of light rectangle/black square/light rectangle/black square/light rectangle. Press seams toward the squares.

Sew the rows together, alternating 3" row/1 1/2" row/3" row/1 1/2" row/3" row. Press the seams toward the 3" rows.

Completed block should measure 10" square.
