

OCQG Block of the Month
April 2017

6" x 9" Raindrops Block

For each block, cut:

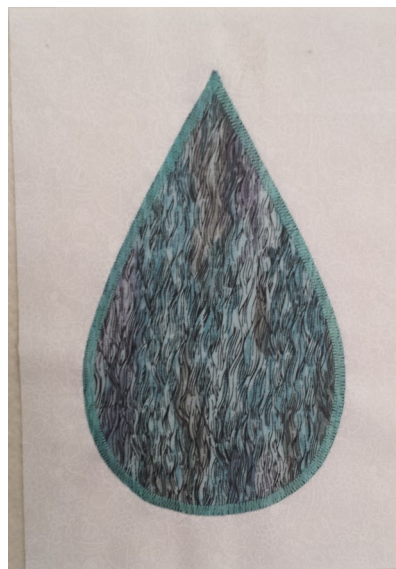
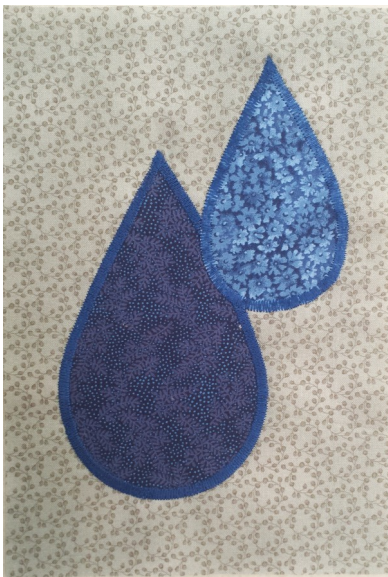
One 7" x 10" rectangle of white, light blue, or light gray fabric
Raindrop appliqués of blue fabrics – size and number up to you! Applique pattern on next page – largest drop should print at 4.5 inches across at widest point.

Machine Appliqué Method:

Trace raindrop shape onto the paper side of fusible web. If desired, trim out center to reduce stiffness of block. Iron fusible web onto the wrong side of the fabric. Cut out raindrop shape and remove the paper backing. Place raindrops on background fabric. Iron to affix, then stitch to secure, using whatever stitch you prefer. Press. Trim block to 6 ½" by 9 ½".

Hand Appliqué Method:

Trace raindrop shape onto the right side of your fabric. Cut out, being sure to add your desired seam allowance. Place raindrops on background fabric. Turning under seam allowance, stitch to secure, using whatever sewing or embroidery stitch you prefer. Press. Trim block to 6 ½" by 9 ½".



Finished block should measure 6 ½" by 9 ½".
