

OCQG Block of the Month
May 2018

Jelly Roll Blue Album Block



For each block, cut:

From blue fabric:

Two 2 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles

Six 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles

Two 2 ½" squares

From white, cream, or beige fabric:

One 2 ½" x 6 ½" rectangle

Two 2 ½" squares

Two 2 ¾" squares (cut in half diagonally: these are the corner triangles)

Three 4 1/8" squares (cut in half diagonally twice, in an "X": these are side triangles)

Alternate option: cut the twelve side triangles from 2 ½" strips using an Easy-Angle or equivalent ruler. Doing so will make the edge of the block be on the bias, though, so handle carefully!

To make the block:

Assemble diagonal rows. Press seam allowances toward the blue fabric and trim dog ears. Sew diagonal rows together to make the block. Tip: to make the rows come out even, fold each row in half and pinch a pleat at the center. Use these finger press marks to line up the rows. Trim completed block, lining up ruler so the points are ¼" from the edge. Block will be approximately 11 5/8" square.
