



OCQG BLOCK OF THE MONTH - MAY 2019

STARLET

A candy colored block which can be created in 3 shades of Pink, Green, Peach, Lavender, Blue or Yellow and there are no rules regarding placement of Dark – Medium – Light fabrics. This block is an example! The goal is a block of each Candy Color twice!



For each block, cut

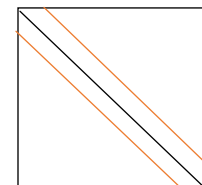
From Dark Blue	12 (Twelve)	3-1/2" squares
From Medium Blue	6 (Six)	3-7/8" squares
From WHITE	6 (Six)	3-7/8" squares and 4 (Four) 3-1/2" squares
From WHITE	1 (One)	6-1/2" square
From Light Blue	4 (Four)	6-1/2" squares

Like a real Starlet – this is a 9 patch all dressed up!

Corner Blocks Layer (1) White and (1) Med Blue Right sides together. Draw a pencil line from One Corner to Opposite Corner. Sew a scant 1/4" line on each side of the Pencil Line. Cut from Corner to Corner on Pencil Line. Repeat with the other 5 (Five) 3-7/8" Med Blue and White Cuts.

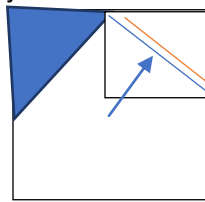
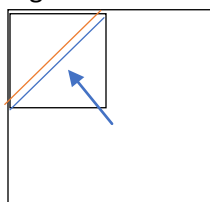
Solid BLACK Line - CUT

Red Line - SEW



Place 2 Half Square Triangles Side by Side and sew together (top row of this 4 patch). (Look at Photo)
Place 3-1/2" White Square next to the third Half Square Triangle (side by side) and sew together.
Press and sew Top Row and Bottom Row together.

Middle Blocks On Wrong Side of Dark Blue 3-1/2" Cut - Draw a pencil line from one Corner to the Opposite Corner. Place 6-1/2" Block Right side up. In Top Left corner place a 3-1/2" Dark Blue Square – Right Sides together. Sew on this line – just inside the line toward the Outside Corner.



BLUE LINE – Draw Line ONLY – DO NOT CUT.
RED LINE – Sewing Line
ARROW Indicates Direction to Fold/Press
Remove Back 2 Layers of Triangle leaving 1/4"
Seam allowance

Make sure that the Triangle Corner you have just created when you press the bottom half up on the fold created by the stitch line, entirely covers the back. Satisfied that you have retained the corner (the 6-1/2" square is still a 6-1/2" square!) you may now trim away the bottom layer of the Light Blue and Dark Blue fabric to a 1/4" seam allowance. Press and Repeat this step on the Top Right Hand Corner of the 6-1/2" Light Blue Square.

Center Block Using exactly the same technique that you used on the Middle Block 2 Corners – You will repeat the process on all 4 corners of the 6-1/2" White Center Block. Sew 3-1/2" Dark Squares to Opposite Corners - Press – then sew last two 3-1/2" Dark Squares to the other two corners.

Sew each row together – Press Seams
Top row Press Seams Toward Center
Center row Press Seams Toward Outside Edge
Bottom row Press Seams Toward Center

Sew 3 completed rows together! Press Seams. TA DA!!!
Finished Block Size 18" (Unfinished 18-1/2")

Add another 15 beautiful 18" squares and you will have..... 72" x 72" Quilt as Shown Below
