

OCQG Block of the Month
June 2017

6" Double Bow Tie Block

For each block, cut:

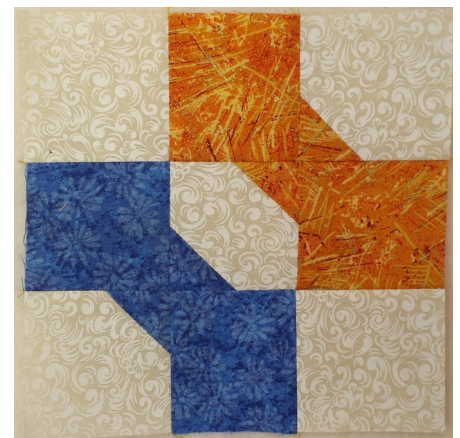
Five 2 ½" squares of white or cream background fabric

Two 1 ½" squares *each* of two different fabrics of quilter's choice

Two 2 ½" squares *each* of two different fabrics (the same as above) of quilter's choice

To make the block:

Place the 1 ½" squares on the corners of three background squares – two with a single different colored square each, and the third with the remaining two squares on diagonal corners. Sew diagonally, making stitch-and-flip corners. Trim the seams ¼" beyond the seamline, and press. Arrange the nine squares and sew as shown. Pressing the seams toward the 2 ½" colored squares will make the seams nest nicely! Finished block should measure 6 ½" square.
