

OCQG Block of the Month
June 2018

Neapolitan Log Cabin Block



For each block, cut:

From “strawberry” pink fabric:

One 2 ½” square

From “vanilla” fabric:

2 ½”, 3 ½”, 4 ½”, 5 ½”, 6 ½”, and 7 ½” rectangles, all 1 ½” wide

From “chocolate” fabric:

3 ½”, 4 ½”, 5 ½”, 6 ½”, 7 ½”, and 8 ½” rectangles, all 1 ½” wide

To make the block:

All seams are ¼” wide. Press seams away from center. Starting with the pink 2 ½” square in the center, work clockwise around the block, sewing rectangles on in this order: 2 ½” vanilla, 3 ½” vanilla, 3 ½” chocolate, 4 ½” chocolate, 4 ½” vanilla, 5 ½” vanilla, 5 ½” chocolate, 6 ½” chocolate, 6 ½” vanilla, 7 ½” vanilla, 7 ½” chocolate, 8 ½” chocolate.

Finished block should measure 8 ½” square.
