

OCQG Block of the Month  
August 2016

## 7" Economy Block

All seams are 1/4".

Cut:

One fussy-cut 4" focal square

Two complementary 4" light squares, cut in half diagonally (4 HSTs)

Two complementary 5" dark squares, cut in half diagonally (4 HSTs)

Matching centers, sew two light triangle long/bias/hypotenuse edges on opposite sides of the focal square. Press seam allowance outward and trim the dog ears. Matching centers again, sew the other two light triangles on the remaining sides. Trim so the points of the focal square are 1/4" from the edge.

Matching centers to the focal square points, sew two dark triangle long/bias/hypotenuse edges on opposite sides of the light square. Press seam allowance outward and trim the dog ears. Repeat with the other two dark triangles on the remaining sides. Trim the edges so the points of the light square are 1/4" from the edge.

Block should measure 7 1/2" square.
