

OCQG Block of the Month
August 2017

6" Stacked Coins Block



All seams are 1/4".

For each block, cut:

Two 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles in the white/cream/tan colorway
Various rectangles with a width of 2 1/2" and a height of anywhere from 3/4" to 2"

To make the block:

Piece the small 2 1/2" rectangles into a column measuring 6 1/2" tall. Attach the white/cream/tan rectangles to either side of the column, and press toward the neutral fabric.

Alternate method (Paper/string piecing):

Cut a strip of paper measuring 2 1/2" x 6 1/2". Using a short stitch length, cover the paper with short strings of fabric. Remove paper, press, and trim. Attach the white/cream/tan rectangles to either side of the column, and press toward the neutral fabric. A string piecing tutorial can be found here:
