OCQG Block of the Month September 2016

6" Citrus Peel Block

All seams are 1/4".

Cut:

One 7" background square, in a white, off-white, or cream fabric One Citrus Peel piece, in yellow, orange, or green


Machine Appliqué Method:

Trace Citrus Peel shape onto the paper side of fusible web. If desired, trim out center to reduce stiffness of block. Iron fusible web onto the wrong side of the fabric. Cut out Citrus Peel shape and remove the paper backing. Center Citrus Peel diagonally on background fabric. Iron to affix, then stitch to secure, using whatever stitch you prefer. Press. Trim block.

Hand Appliqué Method:

Trace Citrus Peel shape onto the right side of your fabric. Cut out, being sure to add your desired seam allowance. Center Citrus Peel diagonally on background. Turning under seam allowance, stitch to secure, using whatever sewing or embroidery stitch you prefer. Press. Trim block.

Block should measure 6 ½" square.
