

OCQG Block of the Month
September 2018

Autumn Paths and Stiles Block



For each block, cut:

From white or cream fabric:

Two 3 7/8" squares. Cut diagonally in half to yield four triangles
Eight 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles

From yellow, orange, or red fabric:

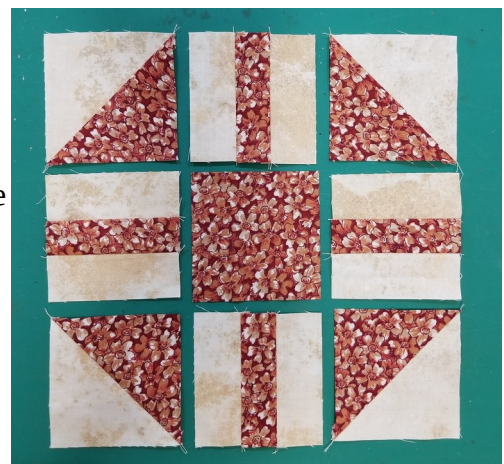
One 3 1/2" square

Two 3 7/8" squares. Cut diagonally in half to yield four triangles
Four 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles

To make the block:

All seams are 1/4" wide. Sew each cream triangle to a colored triangle, making a square. Press seam toward the colored triangle. Sew a cream rectangle on either side of a colored rectangle, forming a "rail fence" square. Press seams toward the colored rectangle. Lay block out as shown. Sew together in rows; press top and bottom row seams out toward edges of block. Press center row seams in toward center of the block. Sew rows together; press seams in toward center of the block.

Finished block should measure 9 1/2" square.
