October 2018

Haunted Houses Block



For each block, cut:

From white fabric:

Two 2 ½” squares

From three different black, orange, purple, gray, lime green, or Halloween novelty fabrics:

One 2 ½” x 3 ½” rectangle (a door)

Two 2 ½” x 4 ½” rectangles and one 2 ½” x 1 ½” rectangle (walls)

One 2 ½” x 6 ½” rectangle (the roof)

To make the block:

All seams are ¼” wide.

Draw diagonal lines on the wrong side of the 2 ½” white squares. Sew them (going in opposite directions!) to each end of the 2 ½” x 6 ½” roof rectangle. Trim seam to ¼” and press toward the roof fabric.

Sew the 2 ½” x 1 ½” wall rectangle to the 2 ½” x 3 ½” door rectangle. Press seam toward whichever fabric is darker. Attach a 2 ½” x 4 ½” wall rectangle to either side. Press seams toward the wall rectangles.

Attach roof rectangle to the wall/door rectangle. Press seam toward the wall rectangle. Finished block should measure 6 ½” square.

Put your name in the drawing once for each block turned in (maximum of five).
