

OCQG Block of the Month
November 2017

6" Vintage Twist Block



All seams are 1/4". For each block you will need two different vintage reproduction fabrics – think 1930s through 1950s.

For each block, cut:

Two 3 1/2" squares of cream fabric

Two 2" squares of cream fabric

Two 2" squares *each* of retro fabrics #1 and #2

One 2" x 3 1/2" rectangles *each* of retro fabrics #1 and #2

To make the block:

Using a diagonal seam, sew one 2" square of each retro fabric onto the corner of a 3 1/2" cream square, making a stitch-and-flip "snowball" corner. Press flat. Trim the seam allowance to 1/4". Sew the remaining 2" retro squares to the 2" cream squares. Press the seam toward the retro fabric. Using the above photo as your placement guideline, sew each cream/retro set onto the 2" x 3 1/2" rectangle of the *other* retro fabric. Press seams toward the rectangles. Sew each squares/rectangle combo to one of the "snowball" combos, again using the photo for layout. Press the seam to one side, then sew the two halves of the block together. Press the center seam open, and enjoy your work!
