

OCQG Block of the Month
December 2018

Christmas Northwinds Block



NOTE: these instructions cut two blocks' worth of pieces. To make only one block, cut three 3 7/8" squares of each fabric instead of five. You will have two small and two large triangles left over.

For each block, cut:

From white or cream fabric:

One 6 7/8" square. Cut diagonally in half.

Five 3 7/8" squares. Cut diagonally in half.

From a red OR green fabric:

One 6 7/8" square. Cut diagonally in half.

Five 3 7/8" squares. Cut diagonally in half.



To make the block:

All seams are 1/4" wide.

Lay the block out as shown. Sew the center section first, in three horizontal rows. Press seams toward the colored fabric. Sew the three rows together, being sure to offset them, and matching seams. Press seams "down" toward the large colored triangle. Sew the two large triangles to either side of the center. Press seams out.



Finished block should measure 9 1/2".
