PRETTY IN PASTELS

12-1/2" Unfinished Block

COLORS: PINK, YELLOW, TEAL, TURQUOISE,
GREEN, AND CORAL – CREAM
PRINT FOR LIGHT and BLACK PRINT
FOR PINWHEEL



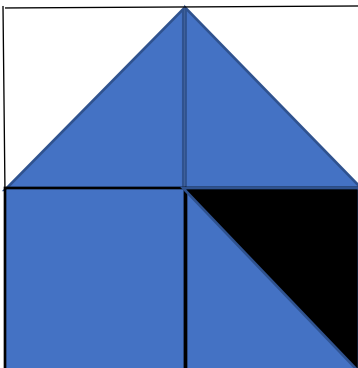
1 BLOCK

A. Cut	(6)	3-7/8" Squares	Pastel Print
B. Cut	(4)	3-1/2" Squares	Pastel Print
C. Cut	(4)	3-7/8" Squares	Cream Print
D. Cut	(2)	3-7/8" Squares	Black Print

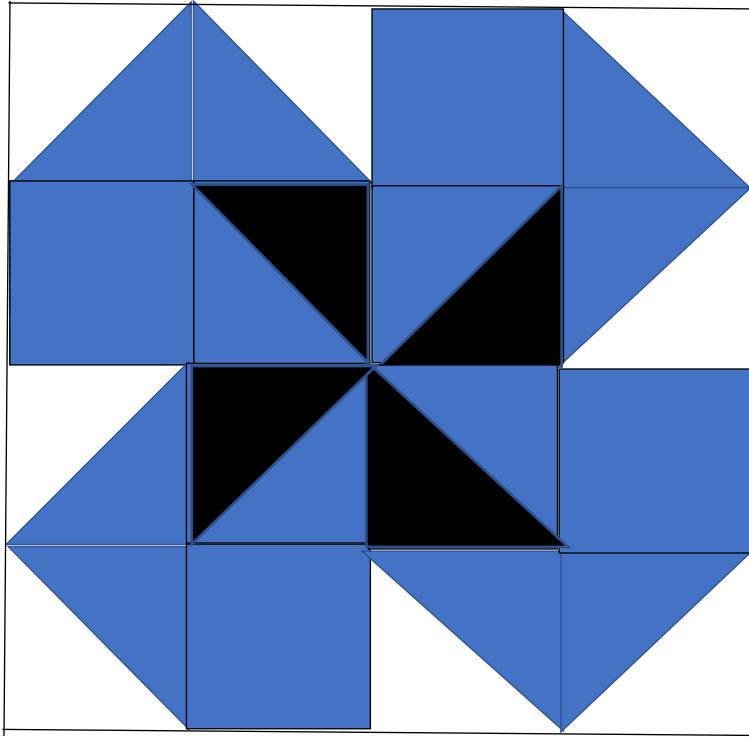
- Use pencil to mark a diagonal line on wrong side of (4) Cream 3-7/8" Squares and on wrong side of [2] Pastel 3-7/8" squares . Place right sides together and sew together with two seams, stitching 1/4" on each side of the marked line. Cut apart on the drawn line; press open to make two matching Cream triangle squares Should measure – 3-1/2" square. Press seams open for a flatter block!
- Repeat step a with remaining 2 pastel 3-7/8" squares matched with Black 3-7/8" squares

ASSEMBLE BLOCK

Referring to Diagram, join 2 cream triangle-squares , a black triangle-square, and a pastel 3-1/2" block in pairs to make a unit. The unit should be a 6-1/2" unfinished square. Repeat to make four matching units total.



Referring to Diagram below for unit orientation, sew together units in pairs. Joine pairs to make a block which should be 12-1/2" square.
