



OCQG BLOCK OF THE MONTH - JANUARY 2020
SCRAP HAPPY BLOCK
12-1/2" Unfinished Block

**COLORS: All Colors (Patterned or Solid) –
Your Choice**



- A. Cut (24) 2-1/2" Squares Scraps in Medium and Dark Colors
- B. Cut (20) 2-1/2" Squares Scraps in LIGHT Colors

- a. Use pencil to mark a diagonal line on wrong side of (8) of these LIGHT Squares. When ready to prepare block put Right Sides together with Medium or Dark Squares. Sew together on diagonal line to create a half square triangle block. Press to one side – snip off the extra material – corner – on the back side. Should measure – 2-1/2" square.

I began this process by laying out all 44 squares for one 12 1-2" block using (2 blocks for half square triangles. NOTICE There are 4 Nine Patches! Sew together each Nine Patch Then Join the top 2 together – then the bottom 2 together – then sew top to bottom!



Each 9 patch can be constructed exactly the same way and it's how you turn them that set your colors. OR... you can be like me and sew them as layed out in the original color pattern!

By setting in rows Using a Complete Square to begin Row ONE and a Half Square 6-1/2" x 12-1/2" to begin Row 2 you will have an "off-set pattern" with LIGHT BLOCKS creating a natural sashing in between the blocks.
