Kaleidoscope

English Paper Piecing

Whether you are new to English paper piecing (EPP) or have used this technique for years, you will learn something new in this class. Each hexagon has a different design in it creating a kaleidoscope effect. We will work on one block in class featuring "fussy cutting" to create your own original design.

Supplies:

*KIT \$20

1/2-1 yard of fussy cut fabric. (12 repeats). A novelty fabric with space around fussy cuts work best. Bring fat qtrs. of fabrics to contrast with the chosen fabric in light – dark shades.

Think about high contrast.

- *Threads to match fabric Small ruler (6") with ¼' markings
- *Needles (straw #10, or sharps #11)
- *Fine pins
- *Marking pencils (mechanical lead, and white)
- *Scissors (paper and embroidery)
- *Fabric glue pen with refill

Freezer paper

*Magic mirror (optional)

Task light with extension cord (optional)

*Available in class

NO sewing machine needed!

Kits will be available in class for \$20. Kits will include the pattern for the class block, hand-outs, and pre-cut papers for piecing the block.
