

# Kaleidoscope

## English Paper Piecing

Whether you are new to English paper piecing (EPP) or have used this technique for years, you will learn something new in this class. Each hexagon has a different design in it creating a kaleidoscope effect. We will work on one block in class featuring “fussy cutting” to create your own original design.

### Supplies:

\*KIT \$20

½-1 yard of fussy cut fabric. (12 repeats). A novelty fabric with space around fussy cuts work best.

Bring fat qtrs. of fabrics to contrast with the chosen fabric in light – dark shades.

**Think about high contrast.**

\*Threads to match fabric

Small ruler (6”) with ¼’ markings

\*Needles (straw #10, or sharps #11)

\*Fine pins

\*Marking pencils (mechanical lead, and white)

\*Scissors (paper and embroidery)

\*Fabric glue pen with refill

Freezer paper

\*Magic mirror (optional)

Task light with extension cord (optional)

\*Available in class

**NO sewing machine needed!**

**Kits will be available in class for \$20. Kits will include the pattern for the class block, hand-outs, and pre-cut papers for piecing the block.**

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
