Alter Quilt 47" x58"

Material List :

- 1/2 yd. white step,candle fabric
- 1/3 yd. outside step fabric
- 1/3 yd. center arch fabric
- 1/3 yd. arch frame background
- 1 yd. background fabric.
- 1/2 yd. frame inner border
- 1 yd. frame outside fabric
- 2 yd. light weight fusible web
- 2-3 Sheets 8½"X 11" Iron On Quick Fuse Fabric Sheets for Ink Jet Printers (photos)

Embellishment Materials

Miscellaneous scraps or large print motifs : leaves, frames, heart, virgin, cross, skull, angel etc.
Miscellaneous: lace, embroidery, floss, ribbon, crystals, sequins etc.

Basic sewing supplies

- Sewing machine
- Fabric & Paper Scissors
- Thread
- Iron on Pressing Sheet
- Appliqué & basting needles
- Portable light table
- Rotary matt, cutter, ruler (if material not pre cut)
- Straight Pins
- Iron & Ironing board (check on workshop room setup)
- Thimble (optional)
- Tracing pencil regular lead
- Fabric pencil white, gray or yellow
- Paper bag for trash
