

Flag #4 by Tina Curran Supply List



For the field of stars

- ½ yard of navy fabric for the background (model was navy with tiny star print)
- Less than ¼ yard total of a variety of six or more off-white fabrics (or fabric scraps) for the stars

For the stripes

- Total of 7/8 yard of a variety of red fabrics, cut into strips at 1" x 20 1/12" (need 56 total red strips)
- Total of 3/4 yard of a variety of off-white/tan fabrics, cut into strips at 1" x 20 1/12" (need 48 total off-white/tan strips)

Note: The more fabrics you use, the greater the scrappy effect. 6-8 different red fabrics and 6-8 different off-white/tan is good. Using off-white fabrics instead of white ones gives an antique look.

Other Supplies

7/8 yard backing fabric
7/8 yard batting
3/8 yard red fabric for binding (cut 2 ½" wide)

Sewing thread to blend with the various fabrics
Iron and ironing pad
Sewing machine in good working order
45 mm rotary cutter
6" x 12" and 6" x 24" rotary cutter rulers
Rotary cutting mat
