OCQG BLOCK OF THE MONTH DECEMBER 2020

CHRISTMAS STAR

12 ½" unfinished



COLORS: Rich gold backgrounds, cranberry reds
and Christmas greens

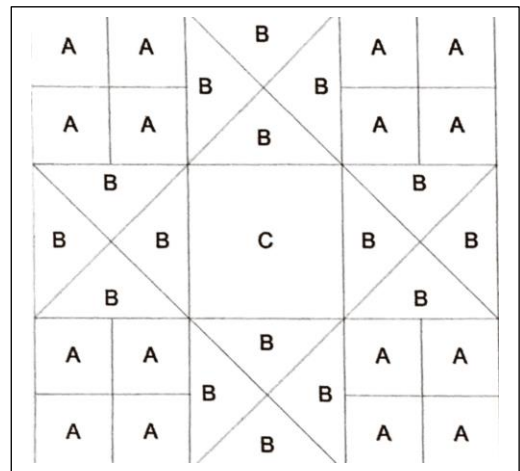
For one block cut:

Eight 2 ½" squares out of both gold background
and green print (A)

Two 5 ¼" squares each out of both gold background
and cranberry (B)

Next cut each of these squares diagonally twice
to make 8 triangles of each color.

One 4 ½" center square which can match your green print or
be a different fussy cut focus fabric. (C)



Lay out your pieces according to the diagram.

Stitch your triangles together, one gold triangle with one cranberry triangle,
maintaining proper orientation. Press gently towards the dark fabric.

Repeat to make 8 sets.

Following the diagram, join these gold and cranberry triangles with another set,
nesting your seams to make four squares; press gently and trim off the "ears".

Stitch the four patch corners together, nesting your seams; press gently.

Triple check the placement of your green patches for the Irish chain diagonals.

Now sew together as you would a simple nine patch quilt and press.

Put your name in the drawing Once for each Christmas Star block turned in (Maximum of 5).
