

OCQG Block of the Month
DECEMBER 2015
Tulip Block

All seams are 1/4"

Cut

From a sky blue tone-on-tone: 1—1 1/2" square; 1—1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangle; 3—2 1/2" squares; 2—2 7/8" squares cut once on the diagonal

From any Tulip color fabric: 1—2 7/8" square cut once on the diagonal; 1—2 1/2" square

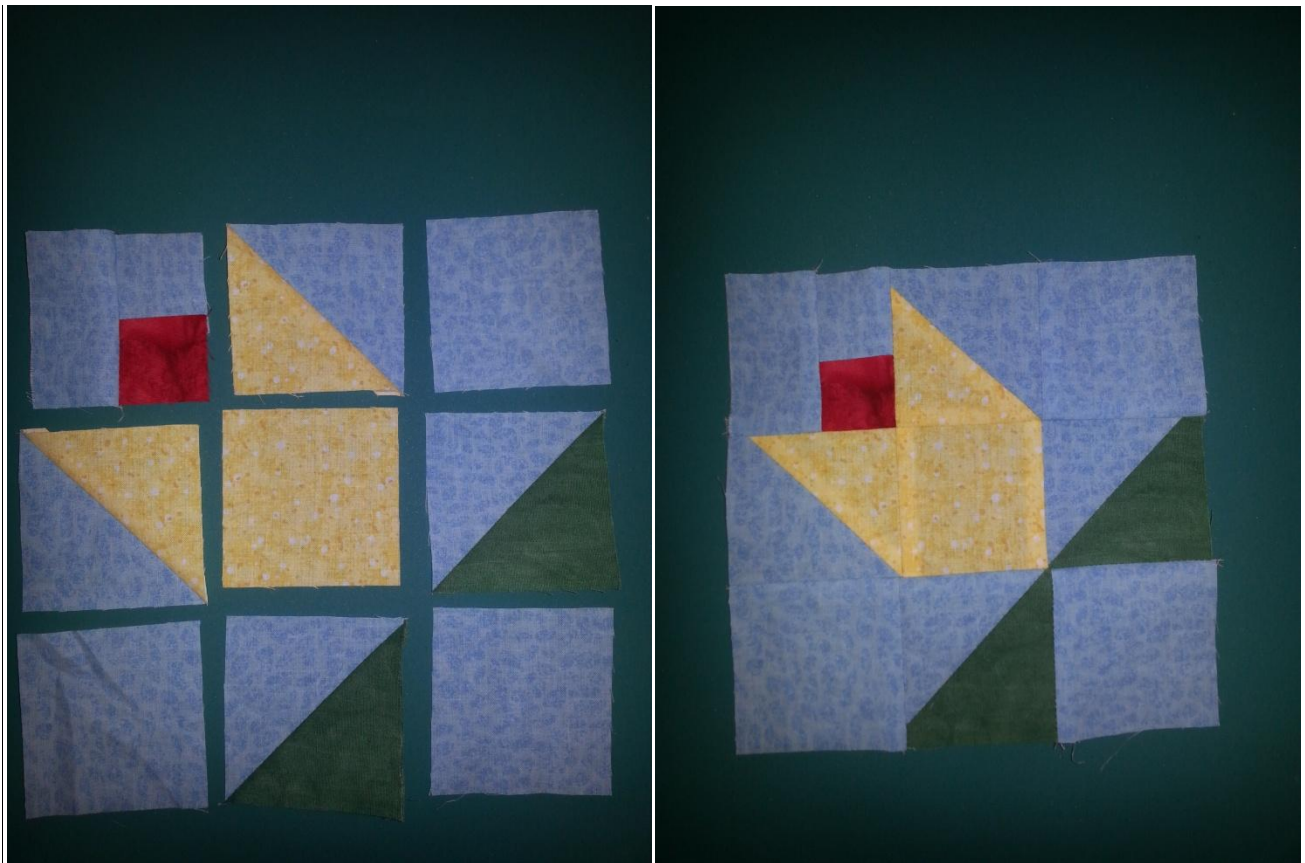
From red tone-on-tone: 1—1 1/2" square

From green tone-on-tone: 1—2 7/8" square cut once on the diagonal

Pair the blue half square triangles with the tulip and the green triangles to make 4 half-square triangles.

Piece the two 1 1/2" squares and the sky blue rectangle as shown in picture below.

Place all pieces as pictured below, piece as you would any nine-patch. Block should measure 6 1/2" square
