

OCQG Block of the Month

May 2016

Sunflower

All seams are 1/4"

Cut :

Sky Blue Background: 1—11" square

Sunflower: 1—9" square

Brown Flower Center: 1—5" square

Flower Stem: 1 bias strip 1 1/2" x 8"

Stitch WRONG sides together of bias strip to measure 3/4" x 8". Trim seam and press so that it will fall to the back side of stem when stitched to block. Stitch in any form you would like your flower to sit using whatever kind of stitch you like. (Mine is stitched with invisible thread and a blanket stitch.)

Trace sunflower shapes onto the paper side of fusible web. Trim out large centers to reduce stiffness of block (see photo).

Trim out flower and center (don't worry about being precise!); remove paper backing from fusible web. Press to background where ever you like—does not need to be centered, but allow for trimming and seam allowances. Stitch to secure in whatever method you like.

Trim block to 10 1/2" square
