

OCQG Block of the Month
MAY 2015
Chain Setting Block

Cut:

From medium to dark blue fabrics cut: 1—3 ½" square and 8—2" squares

From creams cut 4—3 ½" x 2" rectangles and 4—6 ½" x 2" rectangles

Sew 1—cream 3 ½" x 2" rectangle to 2 opposite sides of blue 3 ½" square; press seams to the square

Sew 1—blue 2" square to **each** end of remaining 2 cream 3 ½" x 2" rectangles; press seams to the blue squares. Sew these units to the remains opposite sides of the blue 3 ½" squares. Press seams as desired.

Repeat these steps using the cream 6 ½" x 2" rectangles and the remaining blue 2" squares

Block should measure 9 ½" x 9 ½" Makes a great connector block with any other 9" finish blocks alternating in a straight set to make a chain through your quilt!



Make up to 5 blocks. Put your name in the drawing once for each block turned in.
