August 2018

Card Trick Variation Block



For each block, cut:

From white fabric:

Four 2 ½” squares

From each of three bold/bright fabrics, and one black background fabric:

One 2 ½” square

One 2 ½” x 4 ½” rectangle

To make the block:

All seams are ¼” wide. Lay block out as shown. Sew center four-patch together first. Press. Stitch the top row together and the bottom row together, pressing seams inward toward center of block. Attach side rectangles onto four-patch, pressing seams out toward edges of block. Sew top and bottom rows onto center row. Press seams toward edges of block.

Finished block should measure 8 ½” square.
